**SUBJECT : 67th JAMBOREE-ON-THE-AIR (JOTA) and
28th JAMBOREE-ON-THE-INTERNET (JOTI)**

1. The 67th Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) and the 28th Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI) will be held from 18-20 October 2024, Saturday 00:00H 18 October 2024, until Sunday 24:00H, 20 October local time.
2. The theme of the event will be "**Scouts for a Greener World**". The Jamboree is Fun Oriented with "**Jamboree on the Air**" facilitated via High Frequencies (HF) and Digital Voice Radio Communication as a Unique Element of the weekend. World network of computers for youth to partake in "**Jamboree on the Internet**".
3. The Official Amateur Radio Club of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines is **DX1BSP** as per National Executive Board Resolution No. 53-2017. DX1BSP shall be responsible for the conduct of the JOTA.

PART II JOTA QSO PROCEDURE and REPORTING

- A. There is NO pairing of stations** instead all participating station should hunt other JOTA Station in any amateur frequency, band, mode specified in the license of assisting Ham Operator/Group.
- B. JOTA Calling Frequency is 7.090 MHz (LSB)** all participating station may use this frequency to look for other station they want to work (QSO). When there is station answering their call, they must transfer (QSY) to other frequency so that other stations may have an opportunity to call other stations.

- C. JOTA Exchange** (a. *Callsign* b. *Name* c. *Location (QTH)* d. *Scouting Unit*)
- D. Reporting**, no need to check back at 7.090 MHz instead submit your report with documentation at BSP NHQ (email address) on or before October 15, 2024 with the following information: a. Council b. Assisting Ham operator/s or Club c. Name/s of Ham operator/s w/ callsign d. JOTA Station callsign e. Names of participating scouts and scouters.
- E. CQ Call use** “CQ Jamboree! CQ Jamboree! CQ Jamboree!” instead of CQ JOTA, After the QSO always convey “73! and Happy Jamboree!”
- F. Reminder this is not a contest** after getting the JOTA exchange let the scouts extend their time to QSO at least for about 3 minutes.
